
Agenda of the Meeting

1. To discuss B.Tech Curriculum Syllabi for III & IV Semester under Autonomous regulation 2025 for the students admitted in the academic year 2025-26.
2. To Discuss Honor & Minor courses for the Regulation 2025.

Minutes of the Meeting-UG

1. **Dr.S.Pariselvam**, Chairman, BoS officially announced the opening of the meeting and welcomed the external, internal, co-opted members and also thanked them for accepting the invite and their presence as member of the board of studies, Chairman highlighted the credentials of the Institution, Department and the meeting thereafter deliberated on agenda items that had been approved by the chairman.
2. **Dr.Shanmuganeethi**, Professor and Head, NITTR, Chennai, suggested CO-PO mapping should be revised for Mathematics and Statistical Courses, as PO11 (Lifelong Learning) is not suitable for this course.
3. **Dr.P.Varalakshmi**, Professor, Department of Information Science & Technology, Anna University, suggested that In the Data Structures and Algorithms (Theory) course, NP-Hard and-Complete topics may be added in Unit V (Hash Tables). In the Microprocessor and Microcontroller course, 8085 and 8086 processors may be replaced with processors based on emerging technologies.

4. **Dr.K.Suresh Joseph**, Professor, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, Pondicherry University observed that In the course Fundamentals of Data Science, PO5 (Modern Tool Usage) has not been mapped. Since the syllabus extensively relies on tools, mapping PO5 is mandatory.
5. **Dr. Shanmuganeethi**, Professor and Head, NITTR, Chennai suggested CO-PO-PSO mapping should be rechecked, as PSOs were not mapped for several courses.
6. **Dr. K. Seetharaman**, Professor, Dean – Administration, Ranking & Accreditation, Takshashila University, Tindivanam, TN, suggested In the Honors Degree subject stack, the subjects should be rearranged, as the current sequencing does not match the student's academic level. The subject "Deep Learning with Computer Vision" offered in III Semester should be shifted to V Semester, and the subjects in IV and V Semesters should be interchanged accordingly.
7. Remaining courses like OOPS, HRM, OS, DBMS, DAA, Lab courses and minor subjects were reviewed.
8. **Dr.S.Pariselvam**, BOS Chairman, informed that in the First BOS meeting, the total number of credits was approved as 162. Subsequently, the credit structure has been revised to 165. With the inclusion of Honors and Minor courses, the overall credit requirement for the programme has been revised to 185. Total credits were discussed and verified ($165 + 20 = 185$). The members clarified that passing requirement is minimum of 40% marks in both internal and end semester exams together with minimum of 40% marks in end semester examination. The members recommended this, as the same condition is being followed in Pondicherry University Regulation (R2023) also and the same can be updated in the B.Tech Regulation 2025 in autonomous system.
