Minutes of the Meeting

The Second Board of Studies (BoS) Meeting of the Department of Information Technology was held on 10th February 2026 at 2:00 PM through online mode at Manakula Vinayagar Institute of Technology, with the Head of the Department presiding as Chairman.

Dr. P. Sivakumar, Chairman, BoS, officially announced the opening of the meeting and welcomed the external, internal, and co-opted members. He also thanked them for accepting the invitation and for their presence as members of the Board of Studies. The Chairman highlighted the credentials of the institution and the department, and the meeting thereafter deliberated on the agenda items that had been approved by the Chairman.

The B.Tech. (IT) Degree Regulation 2025 – Overall Curriculum Structure and Syllabus for III and IV Semesters were reviewed, approved, and recommended to the Academic Council with the following suggestions and corresponding action taken:


The following suggestions were discussed about Curriculum and syllabus:

- The BOS members recommended offering Software Engineering course as a core subject instead of Object-Oriented Software Engineering.
- The BOS members recommended including Object-Oriented Analysis and Design, Advanced Mobile Communication(5G), and Unix Programming as professional elective subjects.
- The BOS member, Dr.T. Chithralekha, suggested that the professional elective courses be listed in semester-wise.
- The BOS member Dr.P. Anandhakumar Suggested to revise the syllabus for Probability and Statistics (III Semester):
- The BOS member Dr.T. Chithralekha recommended the following list of courses for the Honors Degree program:
 - III Semester: Exploratory Data Analysis
 - IV Semester: Business Analytics
 - V Semester: Computer Vision
 - VI Semester: Natural Language Processing (NLP)
 - VII Semester: Neural Networks and Deep Learning







- The BOS members recommended the following list of courses for the Minor Degree program:
 - III Semester: Web Programming I (Client-Side Programming)
 - IV Semester: Web Programming II(Server-Side Programming)
 - V Semester: Fundamentals of Cloud Computing
 - VI Semester: Fundamentals of UI and UX Design
 - VII Semester: Full Stack Web Development
- The BOS member Dr. K. Suresh Joseph and other board members recommended the following list of Open Elective courses:
 - Computer Hardware and Troubleshooting
 - Database Engineering
 - Networking
 - Web Essentials
 - Simulation Tools (*Open-Source Software*)
 - Essentials of Mobile Application Development
- The BOS member Dr. N. Poonguzhali, suggested ensuring that the textbooks mentioned in the curriculum and syllabus are of the latest editions.
- The BOS member Dr.T. Chithralekha recommended ensuring that the course objectives are clearly presented in bullet-point format for all courses.
- The uniqueness of the R-2025 curriculum was highlighted and appreciated by the members of the board.
- The members clarified that, the passing requirement is minimum of 40% marks in both Continuous Assessment and End semester exams together with minimum of 40% marks in end semester examination. The members recommended this as the same condition is being followed in Pondicherry University Regulation (R-2023) also and the same can be updated in the B.Tech Regulation (R-2025) in autonomous system.



Dr T. Chithralekha and the other BOS Members appreciated the efforts of the chairman and the curriculum and syllabus team for their preparation and contributions.
