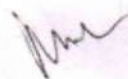
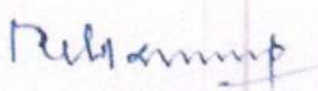
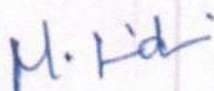
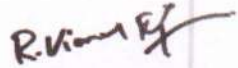
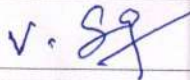
Dr.N.Palanivel, Chairman, BoS officially announced the opening of the meeting and welcomed the external, internal.co-opted members and also thanked them for accepting the invite and their presence as member of the board of studies. Chairman highlighted the credentials of the Institution and Department and the meeting thereafter deliberated on agenda items that had been approved by the chairman.

Item No: CSE(ICB)/BOS/3.1	The B.Tech Degree Regulation 2025 – Curriculum and Syllabus of Honor courses, minor courses, open elective and Professional elective courses were reviewed , approved, and recommended to the Academic Council with the following suggestions and corresponding action taken
Item No: CSE(ICB)/BOS/3.2	Dr. S. Siva Sathya, University Nominee, observed that Operating System concepts are essential foundational knowledge for Cyber Security. He recommended incorporating a dedicated unit on Operating System concepts into the Cyber Security Minor course.
Item No: CSE(ICB)/BOS/3.3	Dr. S. Siva Sathya, University Nominee, suggested revising the course sequence by offering Network Fundamentals and Security in Semester III and Fundamentals of Cyber Security in Semester IV to ensure a more logical progression of concepts and better learning outcomes.
Item No: CSE(ICB)/BOS/23.4	The Board of Studies observed that the theoretical concepts of Operating System Security covered in the Cyber Security Minor course overlap with the Operating System concepts proposed to be included in the Fundamentals of Cyber Security course. Therefore, he recommended removing the Operating System Security from the Minor course and replacing it with Digital Forensics .
Item No: CSE(ICB)/BOS/3.5	The Board of Studies observed that the Open Elective courses Soft Computing and Computer Vision are relatively advanced and may increase the academic workload for students. The Board recommended replacing these courses with other interdisciplinary and less intensive subjects to make the Open Elective curriculum more balanced, accessible, and manageable.
Item No: CSE(ICB)/BOS/3.6	The Board of Studies suggested including IoT and Its Applications as a core course in the curriculum instead of offering it as a Professional Elective.
Item No: CSE(ICB)/BOS/3.7	The Board of Studies observed that the concepts of Smart Contracts and Decentralized Applications (DApps) are already covered at an advanced level in the core curriculum. Therefore, the Board recommended removing the Smart Contract Essentials course from the Professional Elective offerings to avoid duplication of content and suggested introducing

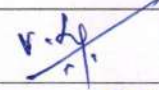
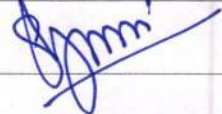
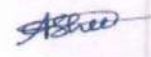
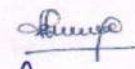
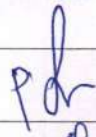
