Minutes of the Meeting-UG

- Dr.S.Pariselvam, Chairman, BoS officially announced the opening of the meeting and welcomed the external, internal.co-opted members and also thanked them for accepting the invite and their presence as member of the board of studies, Chairman highlighted the credentials of the Institution, Department and the meeting thereafter deliberated on agenda items that had been approved by the chairman.
- 2. Dr.Shanmuganeethi, Professor and Head, NITTR, Chennai, suggested including website references in the syllabus, with the title followed by the link.
- Dr.P.Varalakshmi, Professor, Department of Information Science & Technology, Anna
 University, suggested that the number of hours and credits specified for the Theory cum
 Practical course is sufficient; a separate category is not necessary.
- Dr.K.Suresh Joseph, Professor, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, Pondicherry University observed that Universal Human Values (UHV) courses are allotted 2 credits and can be conducted over 30 lecture hours.

- 5. Dr. P. Malarvizhi, Scrum Master, iHCM (R&D), APD, India, and Chennai suggested increasing internship credits from 1 to 2.
- 6. Dr. P. Malarvizhi, Scrum Master, iHCM (R&D), APD, India, Chennai recommended that Employability Enhancement Courses (EECs) be conducted by industry experts, with specific titles mentioned for each course.
- Dr. Shanmuganeethi, Professor and Head, NITTR, Chennai suggested mapping of all
 courses with SDG is mandatory and he also recommended current L-T-P-C format be
 modified to L-T-P-C-SL+TW to incorporate Self-Learning and Term Work
 components.
- 8. Mr.P.Logesh, Alumni, Software Engineer-II, ATLASSIAN, Bengaluru suggested swapping the Programming in C and Programming in Python courses.
- 9. Dr.K.Suresh Joseph, Professor, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, Pondicherry University pointed out that the total credit count of 171 is high and recommended reducing it to 160-165 in accordance with NEP guidelines.
- 10. Dr.Shanmuganeethi, Professor and Head, NITTR, Chennai insisted about Mapping of all courses with SDG is mandatory he also suggested revising the prerequisite for Basic Electronics subject.
- 11. Dr.S.Pariselvam, BOS CHAIRMAN, discussed about Curriculum Framework and recommended minor changes to reduce number of subjects in 8th semester.

- 5. Mr.P.Logesh, Alumni, Software Engineer-II, ATLASSIAN, Bengaluru suggested AWS like Cloud concepts and Generative AI can be included as additional topics in related elective papers.

Dr.K.Suresh Joseph, Professor, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, Pondicherry University Deep Learning Architecture in semester 2 can be named Deep Learning or Deep Learning Technologies and insisted to verify whether the students of ECE had studied Machine Learning in UG Degree Program.
