Suggestions Provided by IQAC Committee Experts:

Suggestions Provided by Dr. N. Alagumurthi, Professor, Department of Mechanical Engineering, Puducherry Technological University

- Dr. N. Alagumurthi, Professor, Department of Mechanical Engineering, Puducherry Technological University, appreciated the Management, Principal, NBA coordinator, faculty members, students, and other stakeholders of the institution for achieving NBA accreditation for the Department of Management studies.
- He also expressed his appreciation for the Institution's dedicated efforts towards achieving overall excellence during the Academic Year 2022-23.
- He also added an appreciation note on implementing a structured format or methodology for data collection by the IQAC. This standardized format would ensure consistency and accuracy in gathering relevant data related to various quality parameters, such as student performance, faculty development, infrastructure, and overall institutional performance.
- He further recommended transforming the institution into a "Plastic-Free Zone," "Tobacco-Free Zone," and "Ragging-Free Zone". By implementing policies and initiatives to curtail usage of Plastics, tobacco, and any form of ragging, the institution can create a safe, clean, and respectful atmosphere for its students, staff, and visitors. These measures align with the principles of environmental conservation, public health, and fostering a positive learning environment.
- Additionally, Dr. N. Alagumurthi proposed including essential information regarding budget allocation in the PPT to seek suggestions from external experts. By sharing details about the institution's budget allocation, the presentation can provide a comprehensive overview of the financial resources and how they are being utilized. Such feedback from external experts can contribute to improved financial decision-making and resource allocation in line with institutional goals and objectives.
- At the conclusion of the IQAC External Meeting, Dr. N. Alagumurthi proposed organizing **a group photo session**. The photograph could then be framed and prominently displayed in the IQAC room, serving as a memento and a symbol of the collaborative efforts between the institution and external stakeholders in ensuring quality enhancement.

- He also recommended organizing social activities to address the needs of the **transgender community**. By arranging such events, the institution can contribute to creating a more inclusive and supportive environment for transgender individuals. These activities may include awareness campaigns, workshops, or support groups that promote understanding, respect, and acceptance of transgender rights and issues.
- Furthermore, Dr. N. Alagumurthi suggested organizing memorial or endowment lectures in collaboration with industries. These lectures can serve as a tribute to influential figures in relevant fields or be dedicated to specific topics of interest. By partnering with industries, the institution can leverage their expertise and resources to deliver impactful lectures that provide valuable insights and knowledge to students and faculty. These lectures can enhance industry-academia collaboration, foster innovation, and promote the exchange of ideas and best practices.
- Dr. N. Alagumurthi also suggested the creation of an **Institute Online portal (MVIT-ION)** to guide students on various aspects. This proposed portal could serve as a dedicated platform to provide online resources, support, and guidance to students. It could offer assistance in areas such as career planning, skill development, academic guidance, and personal development. Through MVIT-ION, students would have access to a wide range of online tools, courses, mentorship programs, and resources that can help them navigate their educational journey effectively.
- In addition to his previous suggestions, Dr. N. Alagumurthi also proposed launching **welcome bots** in the institution. These welcome bots can be implemented to greet and assist new students, staff, and visitors. These automated systems can provide basic information, answer frequently asked questions, and guide individuals to relevant resources or departments.

Suggestions Provided by Mr. G. Krishnaraj, Engineering Manager at Foseco India Ltd

- Mr. G. Krishnaraj, Engineering Manager at Foseco India Ltd, appreciated the initiatives taken by the institution in achieving the **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**. He also proposed the idea of creating displays highlighting the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in prominent areas of the institution. In the next IQAC presentation, it is suggested to include photographs of the SDG Goals posters or displays as well. This will facilitate the students to visually witness the efforts and progress made in promoting the Sustainable Development Goals within the institution.

- He also shared that **Balsam Creative Technology**, located in Puducherry, is organizing several **Entrepreneurial-related programs** for the student community. He suggested that the Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) could collaborate with Balsam Creative Technology to foster an entrepreneurial culture among the students. Seeking their assistance would likely contribute to the promotion and development of entrepreneurship within the institution.

Suggestions by Alumni

- Mr. Abilash, 2020 Batch, EEE Alumni suggested to offer **value added courses on Basic MS-Office, Excel, and PPT Preparation** as it would enable students to acquire skills that are highly sought after in the IT industry. By providing such courses, the institution can better prepare students to excel in their careers by equipping them with essential software proficiency. Mr. Abilash also proposed that **proficiency in Selenium, an automation testing tool**, could be incorporated into the students' skill set. This value addition would further enhance their capabilities and make them more competitive in the IT industry, where automation testing is widely used.
- Mr. Vasanth, an MBA Alumni, suggested that students from the MBA department should be encouraged to actively participate in various activities and events organized by renowned management schools. By engaging in such events, students can gain exposure to a wider network of professionals, learn from industry experts, and enhance their knowledge and skills in the field of management.
