SUGGESTIONS BY IQAC MEMBERS

Suggestions by Dr.N.Alagumurthi, Professor, Puducherry Technological University

- Dr. N. Alagumurthi congratulated the faculty team of the institution for obtaining autonomous status. He highlighted that it is an important and significant milestone of the Institution, which proves the ability to progress independently for academic and administrative excellence. He expressed his confidence that, with the dedication and hard work of the faculty team, along with proper guidance from senior faculty members, the institution would further excel in all aspects.
- He appreciated the efforts taken by the IQAC team to implement the best practices in addressing the SDG Goals through meticulous planning and execution by a separate team of faculty members. This practice is unique to the institution and aligns with the global call for action.
- He recommended updating the faculty members' profile on the institution's website in an innovative manner.
- Value-added courses on niche areas can be conducted in collaboration with industries.
- He also suggested that IQAC release journal covering quality initiatives for educational excellence in HEI's with an ISBN number, to be published every year.
- A separate hall provision may be provided in the central library for the establishment of "எண்ணும் எழுத்தும்" (Numerals and Alphabets) to promote the importance of language among students. This area would feature displays and books of various languages to help students stand out in the multi-cultural world.

- A separate place can be earmarked as "IQAC Smile Please" for displaying photographs of important events of IQAC. Additionally, this place can feature albums showcasing past IQAC events.
- An initiative called "We Meet" was recommended, where one faculty member and 3 to 4 students form a team to visit an identified company. The team would visit the company once a month to understand its requirements and work on addressing them.
- A PLAN Club can be created focusing on areas such as Protect Yourself, Law and Order, Archaeology, and Nature Protection.

Suggestions by Mr.S. Santoshkumar, General Manager, Vell Biscuits (P) Limited, Puducherry

- Mr. S. Santoshkumar congratulated the IQAC team for their increasing efforts to improve the quality of education in the institution year by year.
- He recommended to arranging workshops on Resume preparation and covering letter writing for final year students.

- Inclusive workshops on improving students' learning and listening skills can be conducted
