## **Suggestions by IQAC Members**

# Suggestions by Dr.N. Alagumurthi, Professor & Head, Department of Mechanical Engineering, Puducherry Technological University

 During the IQAC meeting, Dr. N. Alagumurthi appreciated the IQAC team for its efforts in maintaining quality benchmarks in all aspects, including admissions, graduation percentage, university examination results, academic achievements and activities. He also mentioned that the Institution is focusing on its growth in 360 Deg as its evidenced



from the action taken report presented by the IQAC coordinator on all the suggestions given by the IQAC members in the previous meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> Jan 2024.

- He suggested that, the Institution may try for setting up a centre named "Excel through Material and Transformation through Innovation" (TIME). This center could function as a museum, showcasing various types of materials and its characteristics which can be used for varied applications.
- He also suggested that, the faculty members and the institution can take efforts to apply for more number of awards and achievements in order to stand as unique Institution.

# Suggestions by Mr.S.Santoshkumar, General Manager, Vell Biscuits (P) Limited, Puducherry

 The activities under the ICC/POSH cell can be expanded to include more awareness campaigns, workshops, and training sessions focusing on promoting a safe and conducive environment. This could involve regular sessions on gender sensitization, legal frameworks related to workplace harassment, and effective grievance mechanisms.

## Suggestions by Ms. Nandhini, Sr. Excecutive Officer, Accounts & Finance, TANFAC, Cuddalore

- She appreciated the faculty team facilitate active participation of students in various competitions and conduction of various activities by cells and clubs. She expressed her happiness for having noted that regular IPR-related programs are being conducted by the Institution for the benefit of students and faculty and also its outcomes.
- She also suggested to form a committee "Mental well-being committee" to arrange programs such as Yoga to improve the mental well being of the students and staff.
- She also suggested to arrange for Artificial Intelligence related short term programs for the other domain students.

## Suggestions by Mr. Abilash, (2015-2019 Batch), Alumni

- Mr. Abilash suggested that Computer Science branch students should pursue courses on SAP and Salesforce, and obtain Sales force Administrator certification through specialized training programs. He also recommended that training programs on Data Analytics and Python programming which could enhance students' prospects for better placements significantly.
- He also suggested that the Placement cell can facilitate and guide the students to be prepared for taking up jobs in product-based companies rather than the service based companies.



# Suggestions by Mr.Dineshkumar, Supply Network Specialist, Caterpillar Inc, MBA Alumni (2011-2013)

 He suggested that interested MBA students could be categorized separately, and specific tailor-made courses can be offered to them. The courses such as Basic Excel with SQL, Power BI, and Tableau will enhance the data analytics capability of the students and help them find a place in the job market.

# Suggestions by Mr.Vijay Augustin, Senior Executive HR, Modine Thermal Systems Pvt. Limited., MBA Alumni (2011-13 Batch)

- He suggested that the mechanical engineering students can undergo training in CATIA,
   SolidWorks, and related areas to strengthen their qualifications for core company placements.
- It is recommended that for MBA students, training on Labour Law and Administrative
  Law may be arranged to deepen their understanding on legal frameworks essential for
  effective management roles. Such training would provide them with insights into labour
  regulations, employment practices, and administrative procedures crucial for navigating
  organizational challenges and ensuring compliance with legal requirements.

## Suggestions by Ms.Saisaranya, CSE Alumni (2015-2019 Batch)

- Students should be encouraged to take up the real time challenges being faced by the industries as projects and try to develop the solutions.
- These projects not only will enhance students' problem-solving abilities and technical skills but also foster collaboration with industry professionals, expanding their professional network and chance of placement.

## Suggestions by Mr.Sajeetharan, Microsoft, MBA Alumni (2011-13 Batch)

 He appreciated the students for their active participation in various hackathons, and insisted to encourage them to participate in hackathon organized by Microsoft.


